## **Central Tablelands Water Demand Management Policy Introduced**

The General Manager of Central Tablelands Water, Mr Tony Perry, advises that, whilst Lake Rowlands is currently at 100% capacity, his Council has introduced a Demand Management Policy. This policy has been introduced in response to a request from the NSW State Government for all water utilities to implement demand management strategies in order to achieve efficient water use within their communities.

The policy prohibits the use of sprinklers and fixed hoses for residential consumers across the whole of the supply network between the hours of 10.00am and 5.00pm daily.

The General Manager further advised that this policy is effective immediately and replaces the Level 1 restrictions that have been in place since 2 July 2007. Council's Water Restriction Policy will be reintroduced when and if the level of Lake Rowlands falls below 70% the General Manager said.
