CTW wishes to advise its consumers that there has been an increased amount of leakage on services due to failures of poly 90-degree bends on both the supply side and the consumer side of the water meter.

Consumers are requested to check for wet areas around their meter boxes and if any leakage is found on the consumer side of the meter, please investigate the 90-degree bends to eliminate further leaks.
